

How to Create a Puppet Home: Dog House

Supplies Needed:

Glue Stick or

Rubber Cement

Scissors

Cardboard Box with Lid

Foam Board (any color)

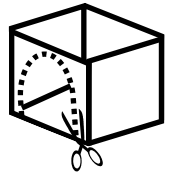
Two Dowel Rods (small)

Super Strong Tape

Decorating Materials:

Paper, Foam, etc.

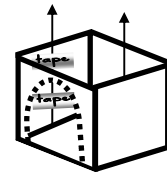
1. Decide which end of your box will be the front, and cut a half circle into the cardboard.



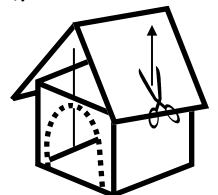
2. After cutting the opening, bend the foam board for the roof into one of the following shapes:



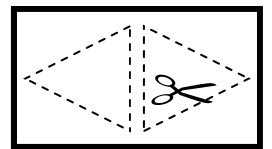
3. Attach the dowel rods, point up, to the long side of the box using SUPER strong tape.



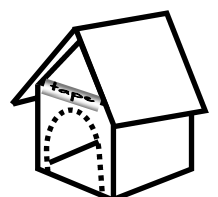
4. Attach the roof to the exposed dowel rods. Use the points of the rods to pierce through the foam board. Once pushed through, cut (with scissors or an exacto-knife) the rods flush with the roof. Apply SUPER strong tape to the now flush end of the dowel rods and on the inside of the box where the roof and box meet.



5. Roughly measure the void between the top of both your semi-circle opening and the roof of the structure. Repeat for the back of the structure. Draw these measurements onto the interior of the lid and cut the shapes out.



6. After cutting the final roof sections from the lid, carefully tape each section to the box and roof using SUPER strong tape from the front and inside of the structure. It is okay if the pieces do not make a perfect seal, you will be able to hide these imperfections when you cover the house in paper.



7. Decorate your home as you see fit!
